## Newcastle

Newcastle Mela is a vibrant, multi-cultural and family-friendly event which takes place in the heart of Newcastle upon Tyne, in Exhibition Park, during the August Bank Holiday weekend – in 2025 it takes place over two days on Sunday 24th and Monday 25th August. Newcastle Mela is a free event, based around Pakistani, Bengali, Indian and other South Asian cultures and is open to anyone who wants to learn more, be entertained and meet new people as well as enjoy different music, art and food in the heart of Newcastle upon Tyne.

The event is a long-standing cultural event in the city's calendar and possibly the longest running arts event within the North East. The event is significant for the cultural and community landscape of not only the city, but the region and across the UK, being one of a series of Mela's that takes place nationally in major UK cities each year. The Newcastle Mela is the only Mela that takes place during a Bank Holiday.

The programming includes contemporary Asian music acts, as well as traditional displays of music and dance, with a range of stalls selling food and crafts. Newcastle Mela appeals to all ages and races, with everyone welcome to come and enjoy the event in a relaxed atmosphere.

# Newcastle Mela Artists 2025



Nooran Lal is renowned for her popular Punjabi and folk songs. "Lookan do do yaar" is a huge hit for Nooran Lal. She has recorded with many Artists in Pakistan including Jugni with the legendary Arif Lohar. Several of her albums have achieved top 10 status on the Pakistani music charts.

Rafaqat needs no introduction. Belonging to one of the biggest musical families in the World Rafaqat has performed at some of the Worlds most prestigious venues for dignitaries including royalty. Rafaqat has many Bollywood songs to his credit in with superstars like Hritik Roshan and Amitabh Bachan. His coke studio number tu kuja man kuja has almost 200 million views. A true International artist with repertoire ranging from Bollywood to Folk to Sufi music to Qawwalis.



Juggy D needs no introduction. Juggy has been performing for 3 decades and is still one of the most popular mela acts in the country. Juggy Has managed to maintain his status as a true performer through his dedication to his craft. He brings any stage to life and is as popular today as ever.

Lehmbur Hussainpuri is a legend of Punjabi music. With numerous hits to his credit Lehmbur is one of the most sought after artist for events. Performing with a live band Lehmbur is a joy to watch .

Hunterz is a British urban musician and has been responsible for some of the biggest hits in the Asian music Industry. "Rehle Rehle" and the "Streets of Bollywood" are still considered iconic works and commercial masterpieces as well as numerous other songs and album.
